HOW WE WORK

Engagement models

Single Inspection

One-off attendance at a specific test, FAT, or hold point — for independent sign-off on a single milestone. Scoped per assignment; fastest to mobilize.

Resident Inspector

An inspector based on-site for the duration of fabrication or a defined project phase, providing continuous oversight rather than single visits. Typically a weekly or monthly engagement.

Ongoing Supplier Audit / Framework Agreement

Recurring supplier qualification, periodic audits, or a standing framework covering multiple vendors or purchase orders over time — suited to EPCs managing multi-tier supply chains.

Exact terms depend on scope, location, and duration. A Quality Manager confirms a proposal after an initial scoping call.
